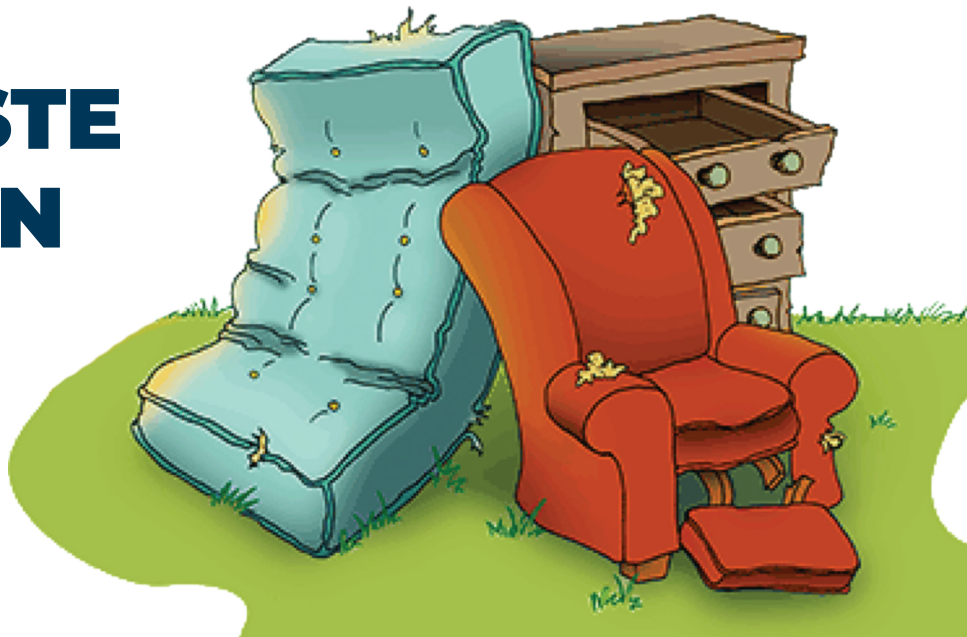


BULKY WASTE COLLECTION

May - June 2019



The bulky waste collection for households currently receiving a weekly waste collection service will commence in May 2019. Bulky waste items should be placed on the footpath at the beginning (Sunday) of the relevant week. This service is for 'bulky' waste only and is not available for premises receiving a commercial waste service.

Some simple do's and don'ts

- These items must be taken to the Grafton Regional Landfill or Waste Transfer Facilities in Maclean, Iluka or Grafton.

(eWaste, car/household batteries, paint, fluoro lights, gas bottles, cooking/motor oil, fire extinguishers, smoke detectors can be disposed of for free)

- You can include mattresses and fridges in your bulky waste collection. Fridges will be collected separately, please ensure latches and locking devices are removed.



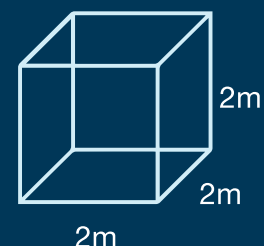

- Please consider donating clean, reusable items in good condition to charity
- For the safety of our teams collecting your bulky waste, please ensure items are no heavier than what two people can lift comfortably.
- Items should be left where you normally position your wheelie bin, making sure not to obstruct or endanger pedestrians or traffic.

- The volume of waste is not to exceed 2 cubic metres (2m³)
