Entries close 4pm Friday 1 June 2018.

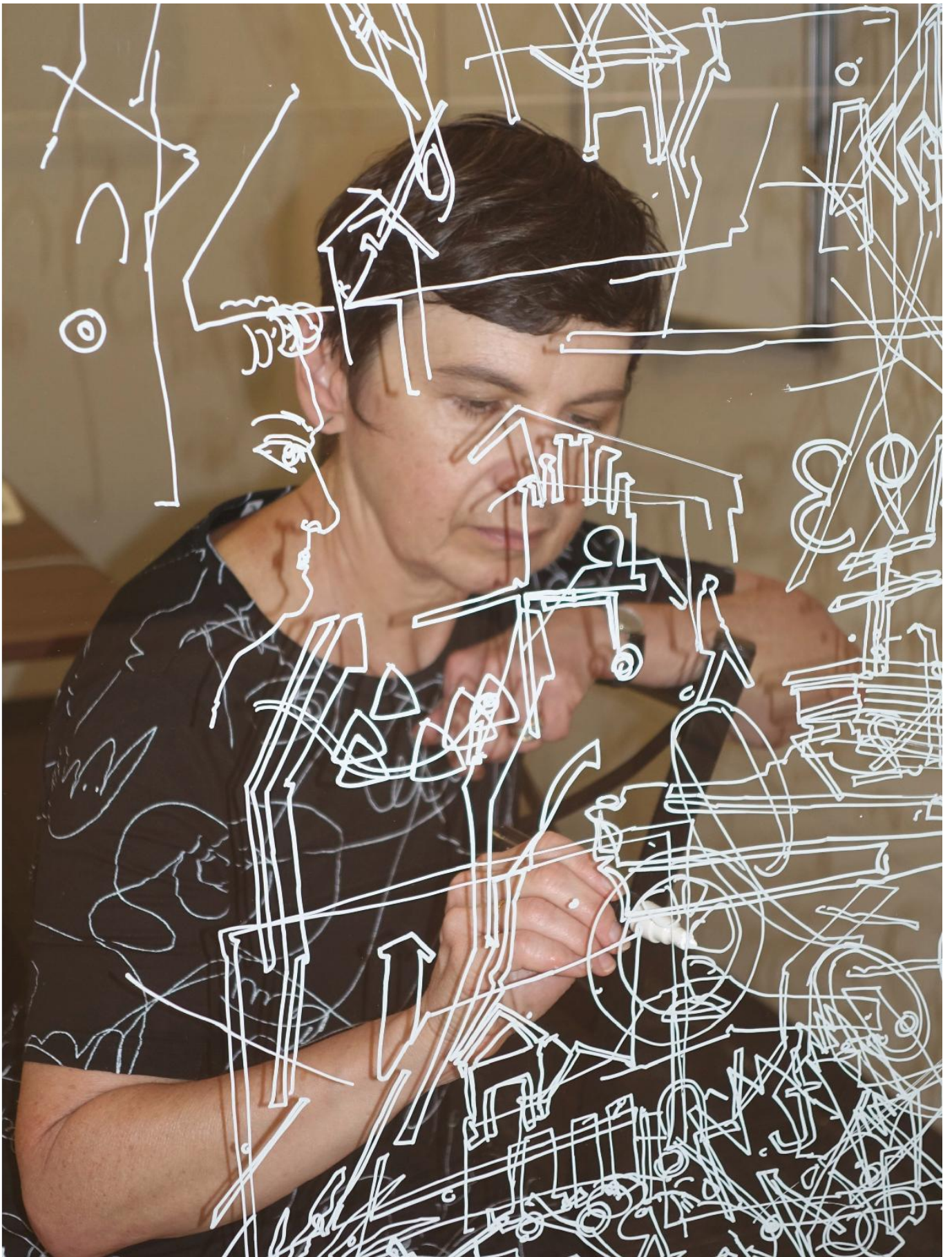
