Never miss bin day again

A NEW Clarence Valley Council waste app has been developed to allow users to keep track of their bin collection day with a customised collection schedule.

Users can opt for an alert in advance of their collection day and for special events including the annual Kerbside Cleanup, Second Hand Saturday and National Recycling Week activities.

Other information provided on the free app includes the proper recycling or disposal procedure for materials (a-z guide), the location and hours of operation for drop off depots, a link to council's fees and charges and contact details for Council and the waste hotline.

Council's waste and sustainability coordinator, Ken Wilson, said the app was extremely user friendly and would encourage residents to take greater responsibility for resource recovery and waste management by making informed choices and knowing where to look for solutions.

"Council's waste icon, dirtgirl, continues the campaign to make resource recovery our aim with her colourful and engaging style throughout the app," he said.

The new app is available for download on iOS and Android phones from the App Store and Google Play respectively by searching for clarence valley waste. Downloading is free.
