8.01	Sports Committee Stimulus Funding			
	In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Council officers have prepared a report for consideration at the May meeting of Council to recommend that the remaining funds in the 2019/20 allocation be redirected to approved sporting organisations as a one off stimulus payment to assist their sport.			
	It is proposed that eligible projects will include infrastructure, utility costs, ground fees, equipment, programs/events and advertising/marketing.			
	It is proposed that the funding to sporting groups will be awarded on a sliding scale, based on participation numbers up to \$500 per application. The exact amount will depend of the volume of applications, participant numbers and the overall remaining funds.			
	If this stimulus funding package is approved, the funding applications received would be retained and considered in Round 1 2020/21 sports committee allocation.			
	Groups with multiple clubs could consider submitting separate applications, however if a large volume is received, the "peak" group would be considered for the funds on behalf of the group.			
	Unallocated funds will be returned to Council's sports ground income reserve.			
	The proposed stimulus will be considered at the Council meeting on 26/052020.
