





Subject: Nymboida unnamed road (Pitkins Road)

Good morning Ash and Des,

...the ongoing saga of the road...hopefully soon to be Pitkins Road... as you are aware the shocking state of this council road that services residents as access as well as access to Black Mountain Reserve is in a very poor and dangerous condition. This was made worse by allowing roadworks to be attended as part of Mr McAlisters development and then further damage from the 2019 bushfires. This year following the huge amounts of rainfall in our catchment since Christmas this "road" is now almost impassable. The road / track has now deteriorated so badly that it would be impossible to have an ambulance attend which will place lives in danger.

We have met with you twice now and I believe that in Dec 2019 you advised that a crew would be sent to clear the drains and roadway when it was safe to do so, this has never happened. We then met with you again in November 2020 when you visited the area and inspected the road and fences that encroach this road reserve, I believe that council was going to not only apply to name the road (which has commenced) but send some roadwork team to clear the drains and have the road resurveyed, where is this up to please? No one has turned up to clear the drains or roadway. I'm unsure where to go with this matter as some restorative works need to be urgently attended to allow safe passage.

Recently, we were informed that a neighbour was told by someone employed by council (??Dan Galloway) that he was not allowed to touch the road and would face heavy penalties if this occurred. As you have been made aware numerous times at council meetings and face to face meeting that out of necessity the residents have always maintained this track in a passable condition. This is the worst it has ever been in the 33 years that we have lived here. The almost impassability of the "road / track" has necessitated myself moving to my son's place to allow me to go to work each day in Grafton. I await your reply and prompt assistance with this ongoing issue. You also indicated that funds for restorative works were available from disaster funding post bushfire...



Reference is made to your letter dated 2 February 2012 in respect of the abovementioned.

Council has very little to do with the Reserve or the track to it. We have included the Reserve in our Canoeing and Kayaking Guide and will permit camping only by those arriving via the river. This is due to the fact that the track is not maintained by Council and is not located within the crown road reserve for its full length and so sections are located on private land. If sections of the track have been relocated it is possible it was within private property over which we have no control.


Black Mountain Reserve Road leads to the Nymboida River Via Black Mountain Reserve.

I object to the proposed name "Pitkins Road". It is a painful reminder of the struggle I have been through to stop this road from disappearing off the map.




