

CLARENCE VALLEY IN FOCUS 2023/4 ARTIST BRIEF

Subject matter:

- Council is looking for images that demonstrate the theme of "*My Clarence*" that incorporates the photographers' skill and interpretation of this theme.
- Photographers of all skill levels are invited to submit work on the theme "My Clarence". A large-scale exhibition at a venue within the Clarence Valley will feature the finalist of each category, as selected by the panel of judges.

Specifications, format and reproduction:

- Each entrant may submit up to three (3) photos only.
- Each photo must be accompanied with its own entry form and submitted online via the official entry form.
- Each entry must identify the correct category.
- Photos can be digitally manipulated as long as all elements of the photo are by the photographer and no stock imagery or photographs are used.
- Your photos require a minimum 300 dpi, JPEG or TIFF file and must be no smaller than 1.5mb or larger than 10Mb.
- The finalist's photographs will be enlarged and reproduced up to 3m height or width on fabric for the exhibition at a venue to be advised. Therefore, the submitted work must be of sufficiently high quality for the reproduction and printing process.
- The photographer may be asked to be involved in the final presentation of the work if cropping is required.
- Clarence Valley Council will fund the reproduction of images, the installation and other costs associated with the exhibition.
- All images submitted must have been taken since 1 January 2022 within the Clarence Valley local government area.

Competition categories:

The competition has four categories and five prizes which are:

- COMMUNITY. Prize: \$500: A photo that shows the Clarence Valley community.
- ENVIRONMENT. Prize \$500: A photo that celebrates our environment, built or natural.
- LANDSCAPE: Prize \$500: A photo that documents the special landscape of the Clarence.
- PEOPLE: Prize \$500: A photo that captures a person or people in the Clarence Valley
- An additional prize of \$500 will be awarded for the photo selected from any of the above categories for use in the 2024 PLUNGE Arts and Culture Festival promotional material.

Prizes:

- One winner in each category will receive \$500.
- The Clarence Valley InFocus Competition will also be awarding \$500 to cover the rights associated with using a photograph as part of the advertising and promotion of the plunge Art & Culture Festival program 2023.
- These prizes cover the rights associated with using the photographs as part of the exhibition at the Grafton Regional Gallery as part of the **plunge** Art & Culture Festival 2024. The photos will be reproduced on fabric and enlarged up to three metres high and wide for the exhibition.

The plunge Art & Culture Festival winner:

- The winner of this category's photo will be used in all print media, signage, banners, website and other
 associated promotional and marketing material for the festival Get your creative hat on for this
 category.
- **plunge** Art & Culture Festival is a month-long event which showcases cultural experiences and events, music dance and theatre performance, exhibition launches, exhibitions and events, workshops and education, teens and kids activities as well as art, craft and food markets across the Clarence Valley.

Competition finalists and exhibition:

- The works will be viewed by a panel of judges chosen by Clarence Valley Council.
- The panel of judges will be made up of leading photographers of the Clarence Valley
- The winners as judged by the panel will receive \$500 for the right to exhibit the photograph as part of the exhibition and in accordance with the Terms and Conditions.

Selection process and criteria:

Works will be selected in accordance with the following criteria:

- The work submitted is in accordance with the "Specification, Format and Reproduction" set out above;
- Demonstrated skill in the art form.
- Adaptability of the work to the large format.
- Agreement with the Terms and Conditions of the Exhibition and submission of the completed Entry Form:
- The submitted photograph must have been taken within the region of the Clarence Valley.
