Some of the Jnr’s gear at Wherrett Park that was lost due to floods but has now been replaced - \$5K from NSW NRL. Question on Wherrett Park – can the Club do anything to help? DS - Yes, the Club can you open doors to dry out, shelving damaged and some items can be removed. Council to confirm the ceiling board material prior to removal. Council will replace the doors with steel doors as part of the insurance claim. Prelim finals 10th September for juniors in Yamba / Jnr finals will be held at McKittrick Park. The playing fields are looking good, far better than many other grounds in the competition.</p> <p>Clarence Coast Dragons (Wayne Sutton) – the club are back training for regatta season, will take part in a regatta next Sunday at Ballina, one in Grafton for Jacaranda Festival. Have been fortunate this season, fields drainage and irrigation project enabled play unlike Westlawn tigers</p> <p>(Anton Sluyters) – Club purchased grandstands, grandstands require 6/8 men lift, concern that maintenance crews will not be able to move when grass growth becomes to high, request for Council to pour concrete slabs to improve maintenance / secure. DS - No current capital budget / project, needs to be raised as a budget item in Council’s budget to proceed if seeking Council funding, recommend applying through Sports Committee.</p> <p>Second point on ground use and line marking with pesticides. Guidelines say do not use pesticides. Lines are marked by Yamba Touch and nothing has happened. Why not? DS – correspondence has been sent to Yamba Touch reminding of sports management policy and requirement not to use herbicide, the actions from here lie with Yamba Touch.</p> <p>Chair – Request to send sports management policy to committee</p> <p>Lawrence Golfs and Sports (Robyn Barlow) – Received flood grant to replace bunker sand, clean tennis courts (works complete). Tennis is going well and Croquet has taken off. The grounds hosted 45 players from Qld recently. The group are going great guns and applying for grants. Need for new amenities block to cater for use of golf / tennis.</p> <p>Lower Clarence Netball (Angela Berry) – one round left of regular season, finals next couple of weeks. Assoc. sent two teams to Sydney (U15/U17) and U15 was runners up. Junior teams (U12) went to Sydney in July, the event was rain affected and teams didn’t get to play. Looking to concrete along edge of courts</p> <p>Yamba Dog Sports (Kristy Ensby) – the club has just recommenced with dryer weather.</p>

The next events are Grafton and Cabarita. Plans in place will see Rodeo go ahead, trying to manage costs.</p> <p>Lower Clarence Tennis Association (Peter / John) – competition rounds proceeding, completed half club championships and will complete other half next weekend. Alan Jurd Club Coach is retiring at end of year and looking for a replacement and working on a contract.
